Oundle Golf Club is a very friendly Golf Club which is recognised as a fun course to play with a great social and community spirit. # OUNDLE GOLF CLUB- GENERAL INFORMATION

Our Professional is Michael Farr who provides coaching sessions and individual lessons for members and potential members of all ages and abilities. He is assisted by Jordan Darnell. Both coaches come with fantastic experience and Michael is currently Northamptonshire Golf Director of Coaching and an Ambassador for the Shires Junior Golf Tour. All golfers being coached by Michael and Jordan are automatically members of The Golf Academy until they are ready to join as members.

## Pro-shop/Golf Reception

This is the hub of the day-to-day running of the club where golfers are able to purchase light refreshments or golf consumables they may need for their game. All golfers are asked to check-in here before playing the course. Michael and his team offer a range of clothing and equipment from major brands such as Ping, Calloway etc and can provide a club fitting service to ensure your golf equipment suits your playing style as well as a repair service.



## Competitions and Matches

We are planning several events for the Junior Membership section including:

- weekly roll-ups and informal competitions on Sunday afternoons
- a new, clear pathway to getting a Club handicap
- informal Golf Clinics with our Professional Michael Farr
- more formal Medal competitions for those with handicaps
- Junior Club Championship usually held in August

All Junior golfers must -

- have their own set of clubs as the sharing of equipment is not allowed
- follow not only the 'Rules of Golf ' but also the etiquette of golf - if you are not sure what that means just ask!
- behave appropriately on the course at all times



# Academy Membership

- £3 per year (for insurance)
- Every golfer who takes a course of lessons with the Golf Professional will automatically become a member of the Academy and have lessons in order to play safely, learn course etiquette and ensure that they have suitable equipment to use
- All Academy members will receive a ball marker and a pitch mark repairer as a gift
- The Golf Professional will monitor the progress of every Academy member and when necessary get them on the course for etiquette lessons
- Junior/Youth members must pass out from the Academy before being able to become a Junior member. The suitability of juniors to play the course will be assessed via the Academy and the Professional will fully assist in this process.
- Blue tees will be made available for Junior members to play off until the Professional deems them able to play the full course

## Junior Membership under 11 years old

- The 11 and under category costs only £20 for affiliation and insurance fees. (unless they have already paid their £3 insurance in the Academy for that year in which case they pay £17)
- All Junior members need to have passed through the Academy and be deemed suitable to play the course following assessment by the Professional
- Golfers in the 11 and under category must be accompanied on the course by an adult who is familiar with the course etiquette
- In order to get a handicap, the equivalent of 3 x 18 holes must be played with a full member of the Club who will mark their card

# Youth Membership 11-21 years\*

- £75 per year (includes £20 for affiliation fees and insurance)
- \*All applicants must be in full time education
- Youths who are new to the game must go through the Academy in the same way as Junior golfers
- Golfers over 11 can play singly or in groups of 2, 3 or 4



## Birdie, Eagle, Junior and Social Memberships

2 Birdie and Eagle rounds can be either 18 holes or multiple of 9 holes. Player must check into Pro-Shop prior to round. Unused rounds cannot be carried over beyond 12 month renewal date. You can upgrade to another membership or repurchase at any time with payment of the difference.
