Greenkeeper's Report

This is by far the best time of year to be working on a golf course, gone are the cold winter days and long dark nights. The course is playing firm and fast. The rough is also starting to slow down, dry out and be less penal. All the normal operations have been taking place through the month - these include cutting Greens every day at 4mm, Tees twice a week at 13mm, Fairways twice a week at 19mm and all the rough as often as possible. Also changing holes, raking bunkers, emptying bins, line marking, keeping up to date with the liquid feed program and watering where required.

During the month all the tree bases and path edges have been sprayed with a total herbicide. This will make mowing round them a lot easier and neaten up the appearance of the paths. On the spraying theme the aprons have been spot treated with a selective herbicide to get rid of the broad- leafed weeds.

To make the entrance way to the golf club more appealing we have trimmed the hedge by the front gate and renewed the bark path that leads to the driving net.

The heavy showers followed by hot sunny days have caused the bunkers to become panned and very firm. All the bunkers have been rotavated to relieve the compaction and where there is a lack of sand they have been topped up. This topping up is an on- going process and will continue through- out the year.

"What 3 words" is an app that breaks the whole world down into three-meter square segments, each having its own unique sequence of three words. In the event of an emergency please call the emergency services and tell them your "what 3 words" location. They will be able to pin-point your exact location anywhere on the course. This is useful if you need an air ambulance instead of just giving Oundle Golf Club as your location. Notices will be placed in all the shelters and at strategic points round the course giving the specific "what 3 words" location.

The work party have been busy round the course, they have trimmed the conifers behind the 14th green making it easier to find your ball if you go through the back of the green. They have also been doing some maintenance work on the paths that run down the hill on 10 and 17. Keep up the good work fellas.
