I have been asked by one of our members, who is a trustee of Volunteer Action (VA), to see whether OGC members can help this valued local charity. VA's main activity is organizing its volunteer drivers to drive its members to hospital & other medical appointments, as well as various 'social' destinations. They cover Oundle & Thrapston, plus over 50 surrounding villages.

With demand for their services growing, VA need to recruit additional volunteer drivers. You would not have to make a regular commitment, but could drive just as often as you wish. You would be paid 45p per mile for all journeys, but the main reward is in helping with this important community service. VA are also keen to fill a gap in their service, which does not currently meet the needs of local wheelchair users, as most of their drivers do not have vehicles that can transport a person in their wheelchair. There may be OGC members who have a vehicle designed, or modified, to transport their personal golf buggies, in which case VA would be particularly pleased to hear from you.

Greenkeeper's Report

Coming to the end of August has brought about a welcome change in the weather. With the temperatures sometimes getting up into the forties it has been a very long hot dry summer. In August we have had 54mm of rain with 35 of that falling in one day. This led to it running over the surface and not penetrating the soil. With the persistent light rain comes a transformation of the course and some actual green grass in places.

The fairways and rough have started to grow and will recover in time on their own. If it does become wet and muddy it may mean introducing placing on the fairways earlier than usual, watch this space. The tees are starting to recover naturally on their own. We will put a slow release fertilizer on in the next few weeks that will keep working over the next three months, this should repair most of the damage done by the dry conditions. Some of the tees will need more renovation works done on them depending on the severity of the damage and this will be done after the club championships while the soil temperature is up and the grass is still growing.

The greens have been under a lot of stress over an extended period of time this year. The extreme weather conditions coupled with the 25+ year old irrigation system not working at full capacity has led to some dry areas occurring. When the green is under the most stress you get to see the weak areas, some of these like on the first green and the back of the eleventh are caused by tree roots encroaching onto the green and the grass not being able to compete. Other areas like the right- hand side of the sixth green is caused by the build-up of sand splash over the years leading to poor soil texture. Where there are bare areas in the middle of the green the sprinkler system may just not be able to reach them. We will resolve these issues with the greens at the end of September during the maintenance weeks. The greens will be verti-drained, over seeded and top dressed. This combined with fertilization and raising the height of cut from 4mm to 5mm will get us in a strong position going into the winter.

To neaten up the appearance of the course the ditches have been flailed, the hedges out side the clubhouse have been cut, the fairways have been mown using the rotary mower to remove the stalks, the greens have been hand weeded to remove the broad-leafed weeds and scares have been put out to try and move the crows on.

We have been working with Jemma for six years on and off now and it is always sad when people move on, but we all wish her well in her new job and hope to see her back playing some day.
